



Covina Police Officers Jordan Corder and Frank Medina were recognized on Thursday March 20th by the California Office of Traffic Safety, as well as Mothers Against Drunk Drivers (MADD), for their proactive enforcement of state DUI laws. Officer Medina received the MADD DUI Award, and Officer Corder was presented with the MADD Century Award, for making more than 100 DUI arrests last year. During the 2013 calendar year, these officers combined for approximately 150 DUI arrests. Officer Corder joined the Covina Police Department in 2007 and Officer Medina in 2008. Both officers are committed to doing all they can to improve the safety of Covina citizens by identifying and arresting intoxicated drivers. Both officers will also be recognized by the Covina City Council on April 1st.
