Readers get a Second Start through the Covina Public Library's Second Start Literacy Program which helps students succeed in several areas. Through our literacy services, adult learners have acquired the necessary English and reading skills which in turn have enabled them to pass exams such as the Citizenship Test and the Certified Nursing Assistant Test. Second Start also provides the tools our students need to be successful in higher education programs at local colleges and universities. In addition, our literacy services have helped students obtain better jobs. Some of our recent successes include D. Nicolopoulou, who received her Certified Nursing Assistant Certification; Lydia L., who passed her Citizenship Test; and S. Kang; who was accepted to Western University's Doctor of Pharmacy Program. The Literacy Program currently serves 61 adults and 36 children with 29 tutors.
