Interlibrary Loans (ILL)

This service assists library users in obtaining materials that are not in the local library collection. Interlibrary loans come from other libraries throughout the country, we do not request loans form

libraries located outside of the United States. Some items that are rarely available through the interlibrary loan service are: print issues of magazines and newspapers (microform copies are usually available); reference books; rare books and manuscripts (unless microform); DVD or videocassettes; audio recordings; bestsellers and books less than one year old; computer software; textbooks.

Interlibrary requests can take an estimated 2 - 6 weeks to fill. In some cases, the request may prove impossible to fill. Customers who use this service must have a Covina Public Library card in good standing in accordance with circulation policies. The fee for interlibrary loans is \$3.00 per item, cash or check, paid at the time the item is picked up. The customer will be notified when the item is available for them and will be held at the Circualtion Desk for pick-up for 10 days. If the request is not fillable for any reason, the customer will be informed as soon as possible.

If it is a "reference use/in library use only" item (rare or fragile books, for example) it will be kept at the Reference desk and may be used in the library only.
