

THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY RECYCLING MARKET DEVELOPMENT ZONE (RMDZ) PROGRAM CAN HELP!

The RMDZ program combines recycling with economic development to fuel new businesses, expand existing ones, create jobs, and divert waste from landfills. The California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, through the RMDZ program, can assist qualifying companies.

HOW DO YOU QUALIFY?

Your business may qualify if it meets the following criteria:

(1) Your business is located in the unincorporated County area or one of the cities below:

2) Your business manufactures a recycled-content product or processes a qualifying material for recycling. Qualifying materials may consist of paper, plastic, glass, green waste, tires, or construction debris.

WHAT DOES THE RMDZ PROVIDE?

1. Financial Assistance -

Low interest, fixed-rate loan program. Currently, the program can fund loans to a maximum of \$2 million.

2. Marketing Assistance -

Staff can help you promote your business on the internet as well as using traditional advertising methods.

3. Technical Assistance -

Staff can help you find raw materials, recommend changes to reduce your disposal costs, and even develop new revenue streams.

Canyon Plastics

- Manufacturer of plastic containers; blow molding or injection molding.
- Loan totaling over \$1,200,000.
- Divert 500 tons of plastic annually; hired 36 new employees.

Peerless Materials Company

- Manufacturer and distributor of wiping materials.
- Loan totaling over \$500,000.
- Divert 3,000 tons of textiles annually; hired 5 new employees.

Princess Papers

- Manufacturer of recycled-content paper products for home and work.
