



## 2013 CITY OF COVINA ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES GUIDE AND STREET SWEEPING SCHEDULE

### Services provided by Covina Disposal

Please contact Covina Disposal at (888) 336-6100 for all your refuse and recycling billing and customer service needs:

- Refuse service collection day
- Start and stop refuse service
- Order additional barrels or replace damaged barrels
- Free collection of bulky items and bundles of green waste
- Enrollment in free rollout service for disabled or elderly persons
- Missed collection service
- Construction & demolition debris recycling

Senior Refuse Discount (based on age and income guidelines), contact Environmental Services.

### Holidays

Holidays create a one-day delay in collection service for trash, green waste, and recyclables. Holidays observed include:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

If a holiday falls on Saturday or Sunday, service will continue as usual and there will not be any delay.

### Household Hazardous Waste (HHW), Universal Waste, Pharmaceuticals, Home Generated Sharps

The following items can be disposed of at a Household Hazardous Waste Roundup:

- Household electronic waste.
- Hazardous waste: automotive fluids, paints, pesticides, solvents, etc.
- Universal waste: household batteries, fluorescent tubes/bulbs, mercury gauges/thermometers, and other mercury-added novelties, such as athletic shoes with flashing light insoles, non-empty aerosol cans that contain hazardous materials, etc.
- Pharmaceuticals: unused or expired medications, prescribed or over-the-counter, used for medical treatment of people or animals.
- Home generated Sharps waste.

### Safe Drug Drop-Off

The Los Angeles Sheriff's Department, San Dimas Station, has safe drug drop-off boxes (in front of the station), available 24/7. Unused or expired prescriptions, Sharps waste, over-the-counter medication, and controlled substances are acceptable.

### Electronic Waste (E-Waste)

Computers, televisions, fax machines, VCR's, etc. cannot be disposed of in the trash and are not picked up by Covina Disposal.

Please take these items to a HHW Roundup or the following **Covina Chamber of Commerce E-Waste Events held at the Covina Home Depot Parking Lot, 963 W. Badillo Street, from 9:00am – 4:00pm.**

### Sharps Collection and Disposal

Home generated sharps waste (hypodermic needles, pen needles, intravenous needles, lancets, and other devices that are used to penetrate the skin for the delivery of medications) cannot be disposed of in the black barrel.

### Street Sweeping

Street sweeping is scheduled every other week and follows your refuse collection day (street sweeping will occur on Monday for refuse collection service scheduled for Friday.)


### Used Motor Oil and Filter Collection
