





Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Can I tour the facility? Yes! There are two options:

- 1) In-Person Tours available <u>by appointment only.</u> Please call (626) 384-5340 or email rentals@covinaca.gov to schedule.
- 2) Video Tours are available by scanning the OR Code.

Are tables and chairs included in the rental fee?

Yes! The number and type of tables and chairs vary by location.

Are alcoholic beverages allowed at any rental?

No, alcoholic beverages are not permitted in any City building or City park.

How far in advance do I need to submit my rental application?

Applications must be submitted at least 45 calendar days in advance.

Do I get a resident discount when renting a facility or park space?

The hourly use rate for Covina residents and non-residents differ for some park spaces and facilities. See rental application for pricing and general policies.

May I provide my own food caterer at my rental?

Yes! It must be approved by the Parks & Recreation Department, this includes "taco man" services. Food Trucks are not permitted.

Can I rent a picnic shelter?

No. They are available on a first-come, first-served basis for groups of 60 or less.

For groups over 60 people, the City offers other types of outdoor facilities that are available to rent.








Tree Roots and Sewer Laterals

Trees require water and nutrients in order to survive and will seek out the easiest source for both. Generally, when roots encounter the sewer lateral, nothing will happen because they will grow over and around the lateral. However, if there is a leak, however small, tiny hair-like roots will enter the lateral and rapidly grow on the nutrient rich material. Eventually, these roots may block the lateral and back-up the system. As the homeowner, in order to prevent root intrusion, please maintain and ensure the integrity of your sewer lateral.



What are the Homeowner's Responsibilities?

Homeowners are required to maintain the lateral from their home, to the main sewer line, typically located in the street, which includes the portion that may be located within the City right-of-way (under the roadway, parkway tree, and sidewalk). Maintaining the lateral includes keeping the lateral line flowing and free of debris such as tree roots. Parkway trees will not be removed solely for roots in sewer laterals.

City of Covina Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Budget

On June 4, 2024, the City Council adopted a balanced budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025, with General Fund projected revenues and expenditures totaling \$53 million. The General Fund budget utilizes \$8.5 million in Transaction and Use Tax Funds and \$470,000 in American Rescue Plan Act funding.

The Capital Improvement Program budget contains 27 projects totaling \$14.4 million. These projects include the Sunkist Park Urban Greening Revitalization project, Bus Shelter Installations, and the Covina Recreation Village Project.

For additional budget detail, the City of Covina's annual budget is presented online in an intuitive format designed to make financial data easily accessible. 


