Wave hello to FRIC & FRAC! Launching on Thursday, February 6th, FRIC & FRAC is a free transit service to help you get around Downtown Covina. Fric and Frac stands for Free Rides in Covina and Free Rides Around Covina. The service is meant to improve connections in the city's 'transit-oriented' downtown, helping to connect the Covina Regional Metrolink Train Station with all that the downtown has to offer. This service is free to both residents and visitors. The program uses three all-electric 6-passenger vehicles (one of the vehicles is ADAaccessible). The route is hop on hop off and conveniently services nine stops within the Covina Town Center Specific Plan. This program was launched as an economic development tool to help make Covina stand out in the San Gabriel Valley as a :==== destination for visitors and businesses alike. The pilot program's operating hours are Thursdays & Sundays from 1:00 PM to 9:30 PM and Fridays & Saturdays from 2:00 PM to 11:00 PM, the downtown's busiest activity.
