PARADE END TIME:	8:30 p.m. (approximately)
STREETS CLOSE:	4:30 p.m.
STREETS REOPEN:	9:30 p.m. (approximately)

PARADE SAFETY

The City of Covina and the Christmas Parade Committee are committed to providing a safe and secure environment for all guests. In order to maximize public safety, the Covina Police Department, Los Angeles County Fire Department, and City Officials encourage guests to review the safety information below prior to arriving to view the parade.

PARADE VIEWING LOCATIONS

- **Badillo Street**, both sides of street between Citrus Avenue and Hollenbeck Avenue
- **Hollenbeck Avenue**, both sides of street between Badillo Street and Puente Street

WHAT PARADE VIEWERS CAN DO

- Beginning at 6 a.m. on Parade Day, viewers may place chairs and blankets at the curb area. **Chairs and blankets may NOT obstruct access to or flow of the sidewalk. Any items blocking a sidewalk will be removed.**
- **NO chairs, blankets, etc. may be placed in the street prior to the street closure. Any property left in the street will be removed and discarded.**
- **The City of Covina is NOT responsible for any items left unattended on the parade route.**
- Once streets are closed, parade viewers may place chairs and blankets in the street out to the Blue Line, but NOT past it. **No one is permitted past the Blue Line during the parade.**
- Dress for cold weather, bring a flashlight, bring food and drinks (non-alcoholic only).
- If bringing small children, place a cell phone number on their person, and watch them closely.
- **All chairs, blankets, etc. must be removed immediately following parade. Any items left on the route will be removed and disposed.**

WHAT PARADE VIEWERS CANNOT DO

- No public areas, such as sidewalks, curbs, gutters, streets, or ramps may be cordoned/roped off.
- No ladders or scaffolding may be used as elevation for viewing the parade.
- Pets are not recommended along the parade route; keep them safe at home!
- No throwing of objects into the parade or at passing vehicles or pedestrians.

- No unauthorized parking. Vehicles blocking emergency lanes or parked in restricted areas will be towed at the owner's expense, no exceptions. Pay attention to all posted signs.
- No open containers of alcohol are permitted on public streets, sidewalks and all other public areas. Violators may be cited or arrested.
- No sale, possession or use of illegal drugs or weapons.
- Refrain from smoking or vaping in crowded areas or when close to other spectators.
- No overnight camping.
- No entering the parade route/procession during the parade. **All viewers must stay behind the Blue Line.**
- **No selling of merchandise or food/drinks along the parade route.**
