## GROUP SWIM LESSONS - Ages 3-12

Group Swim Lessons offer the correct balance of social opportunity, instructional engagement, and physical development for new and former swimmers. Swimmers advance through our Premier level system (Academy Kids), which builds on the fundamentals of safety and leads to competent and competitive strokes to prepare swimmers for future aquatic settings. **Lessons are 30 minutes.**

## FREE RECREATIONAL SWIMMING

Ages 6 and under must be accompanied by an adult in the water. Ages 13 and under must have an adult present at the pool. Proper swim attire required to enter pool or be on pool deck. Coast Guard approved life jackets and puddle jumpers may be worn.

## SWIM TEAM - Ages 5-14

Program is for swimmers that can already complete a lap of freestyle and backstroke independently. Ages 5-8 is an introductory program with a focus on technical stroke development, endurance to consistently swim 50-yard distances, dives, turns, and underwater skills. Ages 7-14 in an intermediate program with a focus on technical stroke development and stroke specialties, endurance to consistently swim 100-yard distances, dives, turns, and underwater skills.

**Fee:** \$350 for 8 weeks (includes team shirt, swimsuit, and cap)

**Times/Ages:** 3:30-4:15 pm | Ages 5-8

## LEVEL & CLASS RATIOS

### Level 1

Academy 1 swimmers will learn to put their face in the water on their own and glide to an instructor unassisted. **The Perfect Candidate:** My child is brand new to swimming. No prior experience required. **To Advance to Academy 2:** Swimmer must be comfortable putting face in the water. Swimmers will need to glide independently 5-7 ft, roll from their glide to float on their back independently for 10 seconds, and jump in the pool and roll to their back. **Maximum of 3 swimmers per class**

### Level 2

Academy 2 swimmers will learn to roll to their back and float unassisted and kick their legs properly. **The Perfect Candidate:** Child must be comfortable putting face in water. Swimmers can glide independently 5-7 ft, roll from their glide to float on their back independently for 10 seconds, and jump in the pool and roll to their back. **To Advance to Academy 3:** Swimmers will need to be able to flutter kick properly, independently roll repeatedly from their stomach to back for about 12 feet, and independently jump off the wall, roll and return to climb out. **Maximum of 4 swimmers per class.**

### Level 3

Academy 3 swimmers will learn a perfect side breath for freestyle and to independently flutter kick on their back. **The Perfect Candidate:** Swimmer must be able to glide while performing proper kicking, roll to their back for a break, and return to their stomach and continue kicking to a platform. They must also be able to independently jump into the pool and return to the wall and climb out. **To Advance to Academy 3:** Swimmers will need to be able to flutter kick on their back and perform a side breath for freestyle unassisted without losing their momentum in the water. **Maximum of 4 swimmers per class.**

### Level 4

Academy 4 swimmers will learn to swim a full lap of freestyle and backstroke. **The Perfect Candidate:** Child must be able to kick in streamline for 15 ft. on their front and back, and be able to perform a side breath for freestyle unassisted without losing their momentum in the water. **To Advance to Academy 5:** Swimmers need to be able to properly swim freestyle breathing every 3 strokes independently for 15 meters, and properly swim backstroke independently for 15 meters. **Maximum of 4 swimmers per class.**

### Level 5

Academy 5 swimmers will learn butterfly and breaststroke and begin to work on endurance swimming. **The Perfect Candidate:** Swimmers must be able to properly swim technical freestyle, breathing every 3 strokes independently for 15 meters, and properly swim backstroke unassisted for 15 meters. **To Graduate:** Swimmers need to perform both butterfly and breaststroke in addition to synchronized freestyle and backstroke. **Maximum of 4 swimmers per class.**

**Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)**

**Can I tour the facility?** Yes! There are two options:

**Are tables and chairs included in the rental fee?**

Yes! The number and type of tables and chairs vary by location.

**Is alcohol allowed at any rental?**

No, alcoholic beverages are not permitted in any City building or City park.

**How far in advance do I need to submit my rental application?**

Applications must be submitted at least 45 calendar days in advance.

**Do I get a resident discount when renting a facility or park space?**

For some park spaces and facilities, the hourly use rate for Covina residents and non-residents differ. Please see rental application for pricing and general policies.

**May I provide my own food caterer or entertainment services at my rental?**

Yes! It must be approved by the Parks & Recreation Department, this includes “taco man” services, Dee Jay, Decorator, face painter, etc. Food Trucks are not permitted. Prep kitchens are not available. All service providers must provide insurance.

**Can I rent a picnic shelter?**

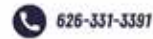
No. They are available on a first-come, first-served basis for groups of 50 or less.

## Kizh Tribal Nation visits the Future Mural Location at Covina Recreation Village

In late February, Covina staff met with members of the Kizh Tribal Nation (pronounced Keech) to begin collaboration on an upcoming mural at the Covina Recreation Village Project. Chairman Andrew Salas shared valuable insight into the region's rich history and the Tribe's ancestral footprint across the greater Los Angeles Region. As part of this effort, the City released a Call for Muralists. The selected Muralist will work closely with the Kizh Tribal Nation to ensure the final artwork thoughtfully and accurately represents both Tribal history and Covina's shared heritage. The Kizh Tribal Nation has partnered with several local cities to install historical plaques and public art that elevate and honor their historical significance. The City is proud to collaborate with the Kizh Tribal Nation to help share their story with the community.
