All Emanate Health Resource Centers will be offering assistance with Medi-Cal renewals. If you need help completing your Medi-Cal renewal packet, call or visit one of our Resource Centers to schedule an appointment with an application assister.

Most common documents needed:

- Renewal Packet (Yellow Envelope)
- Proof of California Residency (Driver's License, California ID Card, or a current letter mailed to your address)
- Resident Alien Registration Cards or other residency documents (If not a U.S. citizen)
- If naturalized: Citizen Certificate of Naturalization or U.S. passport
- Paycheck Stubs (current or prior month) or income tax return

Yes! The number and type of tables and chairs vary by location.



Is alcohol allowed at any rental?

No, alcoholic beverages are not permitted in any City building or City park.



How far in advance do I need to submit my rental application?

Applications must be submitted at least 45 calendar days in advance.



Do I get a resident discount when renting a facility or park space?

For some park spaces and facilities, the hourly use rate for Covina residents and non-residents differ. Please see rental application for pricing and general policies.



May I provide my own food caterer or entertainment services at my rental?

Yes! It must be approved by the Parks & Recreation Department, this includes "taco man" services, Dee Jay, Decorator, face painter, etc. Food Trucks are not permitted. Prep kitchens are not available. All service providers must provide insurance.



Can I rent a picnic shelter?

No. They are available on a first-come, first-served basis for groups of 50 or less. For groups over 50 people, the City offers other types of outdoor facilities that are available to rent.

QUICK QUACK CAR WASH



On November 14, 2023, the Planning Commission held a public hearing and approved Resolution Nos. 2023-025 PC and 2023-026 PC, recommending that the City Council approve a mixed-use development project that included Conditional Use Permit (CUP) 22-7 for the development of a Quick Quack Car Wash, located on 154 E. Arrow Highway, Covina CA. 91722.

Following the necessary review and approval process, the project received final approval in the summer of 2025. On May 19, 2026, Quick Quack Car Wash celebrated its grand opening with a ribbon-cutting ceremony, marking an exciting milestone for the community. The Community Development Department is pleased to welcome Quick Quack Car Wash to Covina and looks forward to the new employment opportunities the business will bring to the city.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING OPPORTUNITY
